

PAVs – Dream or Nightmare? Further discussion of WP7 insights

A World Café...

.. is a flexible qualitative research method to create group dialogues in an everyday-like setting. The main elements are a café-like environment with small tables, a host responsible for each table, a mutual sharing of observations and insights as well as the transfer of the discussion to others and harvesting of insights by visual drawings or texts on table cloths or boards.
